**ENROLLMENT  
FOR MASTER ACADEMIC STUDIES - MASTER IN EUROPEAN INTEGRATION  
(study programs for achieving 60 ECTS and 120 ECTS)  
IN ACADEMIC YEAR 2020/2021. – Second enrollment term**

University of Belgrade Faculty of Law enrolls for master academic studies – Master in European Integration in academic year 2020/21 in the **Second enrollment term thirty five (35)** self-financing students for one year lasting study program (**60 ECTS**) and **eight (8)** self-financing students for two years lasting program (**120 ECTS**).

**I**

*Master in European Integration* is the study program of master academic studies, which is eligible for candidates who achieved 240 ECTS – **MEI (60 ECTS)**, and from the academic year 2014/15 the accreditation has been also attained for a particular two-years study program, which is eligible for candidates who previously achieved 180 ECTS - **MEI (120 ECTS)**.

The official language of *Master in European Integration* is English.

Eligible for **MEI (60 ECTS)** are:

1. Candidates who have completed undergraduate academic studies, i.e. undergraduate four-year studies according to the laws that were valid before the entry into force of the Law on Higher Education ("Official Gazette of RS", No. 76/05, 100/07 - authentic interpretation, 97/08 , 44/10, 93/12, 89/13, 99/14, 45/15 - authentic interpretation, 68/15 and 87/16), at the Faculty of Law, University of Belgrade and other law faculties founded by the Republic of Serbia or the Republic of Serbian;
2. Candidates who graduated from other closely related faculties of social sciences-humanities, whose founder is the Republic of Serbia or Republic of Srpska, as following: Faculty of Economics, Faculty of Philology, Faculty of Philosophy, Faculty of Political Sciences, and others (see: Article 5 of the *Rulebook of Master Academic Studies - Master in European Integration - 60 ECTS*);
3. Candidates who graduated from some other law faculty or the closely related faculty of social sciences - humanities (see: *Decision on the enrollment at master academic studies of candidates who did not graduate from the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law*), under the

condition that the study plans and programs are accorded with the study plans and programs of the Faculty, and that conditions and procedures for the enrollment are fully respected;

Eligible for enrolling are also candidates who completed integrated studies, i.e. master academic studies, who previously achieved 300 ECTS.

Eligible for enrolling at **MEI (120 ECTS)** are candidates who achieved 180 ECTS after finishing their three-years lasting undergraduate studies at the law faculty, or closely related faculty of social sciences-humanities (see: Article 5 of the *Rulebook of Master Academic Studies - Master in European Integration - 120 ECTS*).

#### Notes:

Along with the application, it is necessary to submit a signed statement authorizing the University of Belgrade and the Faculty of Law to inspect, obtain and process personal data for the purposes of the competition process for enrolment and study; that personal data can be entered into an electronic database, that they can be used for the purpose of generating the necessary statistical data, submitting the requested data to the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development, and that they will not be available to unauthorized persons.

Candidates who graduated abroad and in the states of the Former Yugoslavia, have an obligation - when enrolling - to submit the Decision of the University of Belgrade related to the Recognition of Foreign University Diploma, or the Certificate which proves that the above mentioned procedure has been in progress. Procedure for recognition of foreign higher education documents is done before the University of Belgrade for academic year 2020/2021 (for more information visit: <http://bg.ac.rs/en/education/recognition.php>).

Candidates - foreign citizens are obliged to submit to the Faculty evidence that they have health insurance for the school year they enroll.

Persons with disabilities, i.e. members of the Roma nationality, who, by applying affirmative measures, enrolled and completed undergraduate studies at the Faculty of Law, University of Belgrade in the status of students whose studies are financed from the budget, will enter the master's academic studies in the school year 2020 / 2021 in the status of students whose studies are financed from the budget, by applying affirmative action measures that are implemented in accordance with the program of application of affirmative action measures for enrolment in the studies of persons with disabilities, i.e. members of the Roma national minority.

Candidates, who have submitted a preliminary application for the competition and passed additional exams during the previous years, acquire the right to apply for the regular competition for enrolment in the Master Academic Studies - Master of European Integration in the school year 2020/2021.

Candidates, who submit a preliminary application for the competition and pass all additional exams during 2020/2021, acquire the right to apply for a regular competition for enrolment in the master academic studies - Master of European Integration in the school year 2021/2022.

Candidates whose Diploma or Certificate on the graduation does not entail the summing up average grade, have an obligation to submit the Certificate with all passed exams.

## II

### CRITERIA FOR THE RANKING OF CANDIDATES

According to the Decision of the Academic Council of the University of Belgrade, Faculty of Law, **general grade point average** will be used as the main criterion for making the rank order, and additional criteria will be duration of undergraduate studying and a group of attended courses which are relevant for the chosen module:

1. General grade point average shall be multiplied with 10.
2. Duration of studying will be counted in a following way:

<i>Duration of studying</i>	<i>Number of points</i>
4 years	10
4,5 years	6
5 years	4
more than 5 years	0

The length of study for candidates who have completed integrated academic studies and candidates who have achieved 300 ECTS in academic studies (180 OAS + 120 MAS) will be scored as follows:

<i>Duration of studying</i>	<i>Number of points</i>
5 years	10
5,5 years	6
6 years	4
more than 6 years	0

3. Group of courses which are relevant for studying at the chosen module (courses which the candidate passed during undergraduate studies).

*Number of points:*

without additional exams	10
passed additional exams	2

The total sum of points based on all three criteria is used for making the rank order.

### III

Applications for the academic year 2019/2020 should be submitted **from October 22 to October 23, 2020** according to the following schedule: Thursday from 11:00 to 17:00 and Friday from 11:00 to 14:00. Applications can also be sent by mail to the address: University of Belgrade - Faculty of Law, Department of Master and Doctoral Studies, Bulevar kralja Aleksandra St. 67, 11000 Belgrade.

The enrollment fee is **150.000,00 RSD** and is payable in three installments. The enrollment fee for the foreign students – **2.100 EUR in RSD counter value** and it is paid in four equal installments (I installment upon enrollment, II installment until December 20, 2020, III installment until February 20, 2021 and IV installment until April 20, 2021).

**Precondition for taking part in this study program is the proficiency in English language (documented by the certificate or proved by the oral check).**
