IN ACADEMIC YEAR 2017/2018.

**- third enrollment term -**

University of Belgrade Faculty of Law enrolls for master academic studies – Master in European Integration in academic year 2017/18 **thirty eight (38)** self-financing students for one year lasting study program (**60 ESPB**) and **ten (10)** self-financing students for two years lasting program (**120 ECTS**).

I

*Master in European Integration* is the study program of master academic studies, which is eligible for candidates who achieved 240 ECTS – **MEI (60 ECTS)**, and from the academic year 2014/15 the accreditation has been also attained for a particular two-years study program, which is eligible for candidates who previously achieved 180 ECTS - **MEI (120 ECTS)**.

The official language of *Master in European Integration* is English.

Eligible for **MEI (60 ECTS)** are:

1. Candidates who graduated from the University of Belgrade, Faculty of Law and other law faculties founded by the Republic of Serbia. ([application form is available here](#))
2. Candidates who graduated from some other law faculty or the closely related faculty of social sciences - humanities ([Decision on the enrollment at master academic studies of candidates who did not graduate from the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law is available here](#)), under the condition that the study plans and programs are accorded with the study plans and programs of the Faculty, and that conditions and procedures for the enrollment are fully respected; ([preliminary application form is available here](#));
3. Candidates who graduated from other closely related faculties of social sciences-humanities, whose founder is the Republic of Serbia, as following: Faculty of Economics, Faculty of Philology, Faculty of Philosophy, Faculty of Political Sciences, and others ([Article 5 of the Rulebook of Master Academic Studies - Master in European Integration - 60 ECTS, is available here](#)); ([preliminary application form is available here](#)).

Eligible for enrolling at **MEI (120 ECTS)** are candidates who achieved 180 ECTS after finishing their three-years lasting undergraduate studies at the law faculty ([application form is available here](#)), or closely related faculty of social sciences-humanities ([preliminary](#)

[form is available here](#)) ([Article 5 of the Rulebook of Master Academic Studies - Master in European Integration - 120 ECTS is available here](#)).

Notes:

Candidates who submitted preliminary registration for MEI and passed the additional exams during previous academic years, achieve the right to enroll officially in master academic studies - Master in European Integration in the academic year 2017/18.

Candidates who submit preliminary registration for MEI and pass all additional exams during the academic year 2017/18, achieve the right to enroll officially in master academic studies - Master in European Integration in the academic year 2018/19.

Candidates who graduated abroad and in the states of the Former Yugoslavia, have an obligation - when enrolling - to submit the Decision of the University of Belgrade related to the Recognition of Foreign University Diploma, or the Certificate which proves that the above mentioned procedure has been in progress.

Candidates whose Diploma or Certificate on the graduation does not entail the summing up average grade, have an obligation to submit the Certificate with all passed exams.

**II**

Applications for the academic year 2017/2018 should be submitted **from October 27 to November 1, 2017**.

The enrollment fee is **150.000,00 RSD** and is payable in three installments. The enrollment fee for the foreign students – **2.100 EUR in RSD counter value**.

**Precondition for taking part in this study program is the proficiency in English language (documented by the certificate or proved by the oral check).**
