

On the basis of the proposal of the Academic Council of the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law (June 28, 2013), the revised version of the Decision on the Enrollment at master academic studies of the students who have not graduated at the Faculty of Law of the University of Belgrade was made.

The revised text includes the original text of the Decision on the enrollment at Master academic studies of the students who did not graduate from the University of Belgrade, Faculty of Law (announced at the session of the Academic Council of the Faculty of Law held on December 6, 2010, plus revisions and supplements adopted on the sessions of the Academic Council of the Faculty of Law, held on February 27, 2012, October 29, 2012 and June 28, 2013.

## **DECISION ON THE ENROLLMENT AT MASTER ACADEMIC STUDIES of the candidates who did not graduate from the University of Belgrade, Faculty of Law**

### **Article 1.**

Master academic studies at the University of Belgrade, Faculty of Law are eligible for persons who graduated from the University "Union", Faculty of Law in Belgrade and "Slobomir P University", Faculty of Law from the Republic of Srpska (Slobomir and the Department in Doboj), under the condition that they previously pass a certain number of exams, which will be decided upon an insight into the Diploma Supplement for each particular student, and depending on the module for which the student enrolls.

### **Article 2.**

Master academic studies at the University of Belgrade - Faculty of Law cannot admit the persons who graduated from the following law faculties or other closely related faculties:

- University Business Academy Novi Sad (Faculty of Law for Economy and Jurisprudence in Novi Sad, Faculty for Management of Small and Middle Enterprises in Belgrade);
- Faculty for Legal and Business Studies Dr Lazar Vrkatić (in Novi Sad and Niš);
- University "Singidunum" in Belgrade (Business Faculty in Belgrade and Faculty for European legal-political studies in Novi Sad);
- University "Megatrend" in Belgrade (Faculty of Business Studies, Faculty of Management in Zaječar and Faculty of the State Administration in Belgrade, Faculty of International Economics (except for Master in European Integration));
- "Alfa" University in Belgrade (Faculty for Economics and Political Sciences in Belgrade, Faculty for Trade and Banking in Belgrade);
- University "Sinergija" in Bijeljina (Faculty of Law in Bijeljina and Faculty of Security and Protection in Banja Luka);
- Pan European University "Apeiron" in Banja Luka (Faculty of Legal Sciences, Faculty of Business Economy);
- University for Business Studies in Banja Luka (Faculty of Business and Financial Studies);

- International University in Novi Pazar (Department for Legal Sciences, located in Novi Pazar, as well as the departments in Belgrade, Niš, Subotica and Pančevo);
- University of Banja Luka, Higher School of Internal Affairs;
- "Slobomir P University", Bijeljina, Tax Academy;
- University Union "Nikola Tesla", Faculty of Business Studies and Law (former FORKUP Novi Sad, e.g. former "Alfa" University, Faculty for Business Studies and Law, e.g. former University Business Academy Novi Sad, Faculty for Business Studies and Law, Trstenik).

Graduated students of the faculties listed in the first paragraph of this Article can not enroll at master academic studies of the Faculty of Law in Belgrade, because their study plans and programs are not enough accorded with the study plan and program of the Faculty of Law in Belgrade, neither regarding their content nor their scope, and also because the content and scope of the textbooks for particular courses are not enough complementary with referential textbooks of the Faculty of Law in Belgrade.

### **Article 3.**

Candidates of closely related faculties of social sciences-humanities, who are eligible for enrolling at master academic studies at the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law, do enroll in accordance with the revised text of the Decision of the Academic Council of the Faculty of Law on précising conditions for the enrollment at master academic studies, announced on April 22, 2013.

### **Article 4.**

Priority during the enrollment at master academic studies of the Faculty of Law shall have the candidates who graduated from the law faculty or other closely related faculty, which lasts four academic years, e.g. who achieved 240 ECTS, as well as the candidates who graduated at "Shangai list" better ranked universities.

### **Article 5.**

In the process of completing the list of candidates who are to be admitted at master academic studies - Master in European Integration, the priority will be given to the candidates who completed their studies in other countries.
