FOR MASTER ACADEMIC STUDIES - MASTER IN EUROPEAN INTEGRATION
(study programs for achieving 60 ECTS and 120 ECTS)
IN ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022. – THIRD ENROLLMENT TERM**

University of Belgrade Faculty of Law enrolls for master academic studies – Master in European Integration in academic year 2021/22 **one (1)** student, whose education shall be financed from the budget of the Republic of Serbia and **forty two (42)** self-financing students for one year lasting study program (**60 ECTS**) and ten (**10**) self-financing students for two years lasting program (**120 ECTS**).

For the enrollment in the status of student financed from the budget of the Republic of Serbia eligible are candidates who are:

- 1) Citizens of the Republic of Serbia, as well as persons who have been granted that right by the Instruction of Ministry of education, science and technological development No. 612-00-00814/2021-06 of June 1st, 2021, if they are ranked within the approved quota;
- 2) Unemployed persons (when applying for the program candidates shall submit the proof from the National Service for Employment about the status of unemployed person or proof that they are registered at the Republic Fund for Pension and Disability insurance on any grounds).

Candidates who completed the previous level of studies before the 2020/21 academic year when applying also submit a signed statement that they were not enrolled in the first year of master's academic studies in budget status.

I

Master in European Integration is the study program of master academic studies, which is eligible for candidates who achieved 240 ECTS – **MEI (60 ECTS)**, and from the academic year 2014/15 the accreditation has been also attained for a particular two-years study program, which is eligible for candidates who previously achieved 180 ECTS - **MEI (120 ECTS)**.

The official language of *Master in European Integration* is English.

Eligible for **MEI (60 ECTS)** are:

1. Candidates who have completed undergraduate academic studies, i.e. undergraduate four-year studies according to the laws that were valid before the entry into force of the Law on Higher Education ("Official Gazette of RS", No. 76/05, 100/07 - authentic interpretation, 97/08 , 44/10, 93/12, 89/13, 99/14, 45/15 - authentic interpretation, 68/15 and 87/16), at the Faculty of Law, University of Belgrade and other law faculties founded by the Republic of Serbia or the Republic of Srpska;
2. Candidates who graduated from other closely related faculties of social sciences-humanities, whose founder is the Republic of Serbia or Republic of Srpska, as following: Faculty of Economics, Faculty of Philology, Faculty of Philosophy, Faculty of Political Sciences, and others (in accordance with *Decision of précising conditions for enrollment at master academic studies* of September 23, 2019 and December 7, 2020);
3. Candidates who graduated from some other law faculty or the closely related faculty of social sciences - humanities (in accordance with *Decision on the enrollment at master academic studies of candidates who did not graduate from the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law*), under the condition that the study plans and programs are accorded with the study plans and programs of the Faculty, and that conditions and procedures for the enrollment are fully respected.

Eligible for enrolling are also candidates who completed integrated studies, i.e. master academic studies, who previously achieved 300 ECTS.

Eligible for enrolling at **MEI (120 ECTS)** are candidates who achieved 180 ECTS after finishing their three-years lasting undergraduate studies at the law faculty, or closely related faculty of social sciences-humanities (in accordance with *Decision of précising conditions for enrollment at master academic studies* of September 23, 2019 and December 7, 2020).

Notes:

Applications can be submitted only by candidates who completed previous level of studies until September 30th, 2021.

Along with the application, it is necessary to submit a signed statement authorizing the University of Belgrade and the Faculty of Law to inspect, obtain and process personal data for the purposes of the competition process for enrolment and study; that personal data can be entered into an electronic database, that they can be used for the purpose of generating the necessary statistical data, submitting the requested data to the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development, and that they will not be available to unauthorized persons.

Candidates who graduated abroad and in the states of the Former Yugoslavia, have an obligation - when enrolling - to submit the Decision of the University of Belgrade related to the Recognition of Foreign University Diploma, or the Certificate which proves that the above mentioned procedure has been in progress. Procedure for recognition of foreign higher education documents is done before the University of Belgrade for academic year 2021/2022 (for more information visit: <http://bg.ac.rs/en/education/recognition.php>).

Candidates - foreign citizens are obliged to submit to the Faculty evidence that they have health insurance for the academic year they enroll.

Persons with disabilities, i.e. members of the Roma nationality, who, by applying affirmative measures, enrolled and completed undergraduate studies in the status of students whose studies are financed from the budget, will enter the master's academic studies in the academic year 2021/2022 in the status of students whose studies are financed from the budget, by applying affirmative action measures that are implemented in accordance with the program of application of affirmative action measures for enrolment in the studies of persons with disabilities, i.e. members of the Roma national minority.

Diploma on completed first cycle of higher education within academic studies that candidate obtained with recognition of part of study program of applied studies shall be considered valid for enrollment to master academic studies only if the scope of recognized exams from study program of applied studies is not higher than 30% of total scope of study program of academic studies on which diploma is obtained (72/240 ECTS, i.e. 54/180 ECTS according to Rulebook on standards and procedure for accreditation of study programs).

Candidates, who have submitted a preliminary application for the enrollment and passed additional exams during the previous years, acquire the right to apply for enrolment in the master academic studies - Master of European Integration in the academic year 2021/2022.

Candidates, who submit a preliminary application for the competition and pass all additional exams during 2021/2022, acquire the right to apply for enrolment in the master academic studies - Master of European Integration in the school year 2022/2023.

Candidates whose Diploma or Certificate on the graduation does not entail the grade point average, have an obligation to submit the Certificate with all passed exams.

For the enrollment in the status of student financed from the budget of the Republic of Serbia eligible are candidates who are:

- 3) Citizens of the Republic of Serbia, as well as persons who have been granted that right by the Instruction of Ministry of education, science and technological development No. 612-00-00814/2021-06 of June 1st, 2021, if they are ranked within the approved quota;
- 4) Unemployed persons (when applying for the program candidates shall submit the proof from the National Service for Employment about the status of unemployed person or proof that they are registered at the Republic Fund for Pension and Disability insurance on any grounds).

Candidates who completed the previous level of studies before the 2020/21 academic year when applying also submit a signed statement that they were not enrolled in the first year of master's academic studies in budget status.

CRITERIA FOR THE RANKING OF CANDIDATES

According to the Decision of the Academic Council of the University of Belgrade, Faculty of Law, **general grade point average** will be used as the main criterion for making the rank order, and additional criteria will be duration of undergraduate studying and a group of attended courses which are relevant for the chosen module:

1. General grade point average shall be multiplied with 10.

For persons who completed Bachelor academic studies or integrated studies, grade point average obtained at that level of studies is considered.

For persons who completed Master academic studies, general grade point average (GGPA) is calculated on the basis of grade point averages obtained at Bachelor academic studies (GPA BA) and Master academic studies (GPA MA), pondered by length of study program at Bachelor academic studies and Master academic studies expressed in ECTS (BA ECTS + MA ECTS).

$$\text{General grade point average (GGPA)} = \frac{\text{GPA BA} \times \text{BA ECTS} + \text{GPA MA} \times \text{MA ECTS}}{\text{BA ECTS} + \text{MA ECTS}}$$

For candidates who have completed undergraduate academic studies, i.e. undergraduate four-year studies according to the laws that were valid before the entry into force of the Law on Higher Education ("Official Gazette of RS", No. 76/05, 100/07 - authentic interpretation, 97/08, 44/10, 93/12, 89/13, 99/14, 45/15 - authentic interpretation, 68/15 and 87/16), grade point average obtained at that studies is considered, including grade at final graduation thesis, in case it exists.

2. Duration of studying will be counted in a following way:

<i>Duration of studying</i>	<i>Number of points</i>
4 years	10
4,5 years	6
5 years	4
more than 5 years	0

The length of study for candidates who have completed integrated academic studies and candidates who have achieved 300 ECTS in academic studies (180 BAS + 120 MAS) will be scored as follows:

<i>Duration of studying</i>	<i>Number of points</i>
5 years	10
5,5 years	6
6 years	4
more than 6 years	0

3. Group of courses which are relevant for studying at the chosen module (courses which the candidate passed during undergraduate studies) – courses within previously completed study program, evaluated by the Academic-Scientific Council of the Faculty of Law which are relevant for studying at the chosen module – potential obligation to pass additional exams).

Number of points:

without additional exams
(candidates from point 1) 10

passed additional exams
(candidates from points 2 and 3) 2

The total sum of points based on all three criteria is used for making the rank order.

III

Applications for the Third enrollment term should be submitted from November 2 to November 3, 2021 according to the following schedule: Tuesdays from 11:00 to 17:00 and Wednesdays from 11:00 to 13:30. Applications can also be sent by mail to the address: University of Belgrade - Faculty of Law, Department of Master and Doctoral Studies, Bulevar kralja Aleksandra St. 67, 11000 Belgrade.

The enrollment fee is **150.000,00 RSD** and is payable in four installments. The enrollment fee for the foreign students – **2.100 EUR in RSD counter value** and it is paid in four equal installments (I installment upon enrollment, II installment until December 20, 2021, III installment until February 20, 2022 and IV installment until April 20, 2022).

Precondition for taking part in this study program is the proficiency in English language (documented by the certificate or proved by the oral check).
